## 1 Latest instances of cybercrime


There have been a high number of cases of online shopping fraud and the illegal access of online banking accounts.

Crime organizations recruit exchange students and technical trainees to take part in crimes under the guise of it being an easy, lucrative part-time job.

## 2 Examples of taking part in crimes

#### (1) Illegally receiving goods

Taking delivered items by pretending to be the recipient and transferring to the specified address.



## (2) Making purchases via barcode

To purchase items using another person's barcode, then sending the item to the specified address.



### (3) Transferring and trading bank account (or ATM card)

To sell, buy or transfer your bank account (or ATM card) for free.



You should never be tempted by fraudulent promises on social media such as "it is a good part time job", it is just receiving items", "it is just purchasing items", or "if you open and transfer your bank account, you' Il make money". These are all crimes. If you commit these acts, you might be arrested or deported.
